

# Meet & Facilities Information

## Clerking & Event Calls

Athletes and relay teams are to report to the appropriate Clerking area by the second call of that event. The call system will be: First Call--Second Call--Third & Final Call. Athletes should report to the event clerk by the second call for the event. Heats & flights will be formed following the final call for each event. Athletes who report after the deadline will be scratched with that event counting towards that athlete's participation limitation.

For running events, the clerk of the course will be located at the north end of the football stadium adjacent to the track. Clerking for field events will be done at the site of each event. Relays teams will check-in by submitting their completed and signed relay cards. All four relay members must be present at check-in.

Event clerks may use a loudspeaker system in the clerking area to assist in the calling of athletes and the forming of heats.

## Appeals Board

The head referee will be the final authority on judgments and interpretation of rules. A board of appeals may be called if it is deemed necessary by the head referee and meet director. The board will consist of a men's and women's coach and the head referee. If called, please respond immediately. All decisions by the Appeals Board shall be final. JUDGMENT CALLS MADE BY OFFICIALS MAY NOT BE APPEALED.

## Starting Blocks & Shots/Discs

Saline High School will provide starting blocks. Competitors will not be permitted to use their own blocks. Each school should bring its own shots & discs, which must be inspected and weighed prior to use.

## Video Arrangements

Meet management will use a video camera to determine final placing in events when finish line judges are unable to confidently identify a finish order. This is the only video equipment that will be used to make decisions related to the meet.

## Team Camps

Tents and team camps must be located away from the track. There is space available for team camps on the hill at the northeastern corner of the stadium.

## Track Marking

Chalk will be provided to mark the track and runways. Athletes may not use tape or other markers.

## **Spikes**

Athletes may wear needle spikes of ¼" or less.

## **Locker Rooms & Restrooms**

Locker rooms and showers WILL NOT be available at the regional site. Restrooms are located on either side of the concessions stand.

## **Athletic Trainer**

The Saline Area Schools Athletic Trainer WILL be available at the site.

## **Warm-Up**

The track will be available for warm-up prior to the start of prelims and during the morning break. During competition, athletes can warm-up in the stadium adjacent to the track.

## **Spectator & Bus Parking**

Please remind your team's spectators that they may only park in designated spots. Any cars parked in the grass, on the side of the roads, or in any "No Parking" area will be removed.

Parking for spectators is available in any of the lots adjacent to the track. There is an overflow lot available on the far side of the high school.

Team busses should park in the lots south of the track at the softball/baseball fields.

## **Spectator Admission**

Adults and Students will be charged \$5 at the gate. This is valid for admission to the morning and afternoon sessions. No passes will be accepted. If leaving the track, please ask to be marked for readmission.

## **Athlete Admission**

Athletes will enter the track via the same entrance as spectators.

## **Concessions**

Hot dogs, hamburgers, pizza, candy, Gatorade, water, etc... will be available throughout the morning and afternoon sessions.

## **Grills & Cook Outs**

Private grills and cookouts are not permitted in or near the track & field facility.

## **Exclusion from Other Facilities**

The track and stadium have been reserved for the regional. All other school facilities are strictly off limits. Athletes and spectators may not enter the high school or the other athletic facilities.
